The Antarctic ice sheet, containing enough ice to raise global sea level by >58m (Fretwell and others, 2013), includes large ice shelves These floating extensions drain >80% of its grounded ice into the oceans Ice shelves modulate the rate at which grounded ice is released into the oceans: the buttressing effect of ice shelves lends stability to the grounded parts of the Antarctic ice sheet

Vegetation reaches quasi-equilibrium after ~350 years, and the vegetation establishment results in global increases in temperature (~25 C), precipitation (~55%) and evapotranspiration as well as declines in albedo and sea ice volumes In high latitude regions, vegetation establishment decreases albedo, causing an increase in global temperatures as well as a northward shift of the

The current contribution of the Antarctic ice sheet to global sea level rise is x mm (1992 -2017) but over the last decades a strong trend of mass loss acceleration was observed for the WAIS after ice shelves and glaciers retreated and thinned (IMBIE, 2018) In contrast, there is no clear trend in the mass balance of the East Antarctic Ice Sheet (EAIS) as since the 1990s Altimetry
