Europe After the Fall of Rome • As Roman authority crumbled it was replaced by strong local leadership, aka the WARRIOR LORDS • Various Northern tribes like the Germanic Franks, the Visgoths, the Saxons, the Celts and the Norse, had invaded or settled in Roman territories during the previous centuries • The Church, which remained centered in Rome also gained influence at this time
