Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services in Scotland are arranged in four 'tiers' of care Support at tier one may be provided by people working in universal services Tier two support is often provided by CAMH workers in primary care or community settings Tier three is specialist support for people with severe, complex and persistent disorders Tier four provides specialist services

Mental health problems in children and young people

The British Child and Adolescent Mental Health Surveys in 1999 and 2004 found that 1 in 10 children and young people under the age of 16 had a diagnosable mental disorder Among the 5 to 10 year olds, 10% of boys and 5% of girls had a mental health problem while among the 11 to 16 year olds the prevalence was 13% for boys and 10% for girls 2,3 The most common problems are conduct ...
