writing of England in 1784 Introduction By 1850, at the apogee of its power, Britain had 18% of world population The area of the British Isles is only about 0.16% of the world land mass Yet Britain then produced two-thirds of world output of coal and one half of world production of cotton textiles and iron Output per worker was higher in Britain than in any other country It had enormous
