Person-centered psychotherapy (also known as client-centered or Rogerian therapy) is a form of talk therapy developed by Carl Rogers in the 1940s and 1950s The purpose of this form of therapy is to increase a person's feelings of self-worth, reduce the level of incongruence between the ideal and actual self, and help a person become more fully functioning Rogers's strong belief in the
