Topographic Maps: The basics

Maps are made to scale In each case, the scale represents the ratio of a distance on the map to the actual distance on the ground A standard Canadian topographic map is produced at 1:50 000, where 2 cm on the map represents 1 km on the ground Medium-scale maps (eg 1:50 000) cover smaller areas in greater detail, whereas small-scale maps
