Non-violent resistance offers you a completely different pattern which aims to help you to stop the child's or young person's destructive behaviour and prevent escalation and violence Experience and research show that it is very effective The main principles of NVR are: 1 Taking a firm stand against violence, risk-taking and anti-social behaviours 2 Holding back from physical or verbal

Nonviolent resistance (NVR) is a new training model aimed at helping parents deal effectively with their helplessness, isolation, and escalatory interactions with their children The purpose of this study is to evaluate training in NVR with the parents of children with acute behavior problems Seventy-three parents (41 families) were randomly assigned to a treatment group and wait-list
