Highest suicide rate in the OECD Korea's suicide rate is the highest in the OECD Contrary to patterns seen in most OECD countries, it has risen significantly in the last decade While suicide rates have stabilised slightly since 2009, after reaching a high of 333 deaths per 100 000 in 2011 compared to the OECD average of 124, recently released data shows a drop in suicide to 291 This
