Treatment, service delivery and long-term follow-up

210 people diagnosed with general anxiety, panic disorder, or minor depression, were randomly allocated to drug treatment, cognitive behaviour therapy, self-help, or placebo medication. Treatment was completed within 10 weeks. The participants were assessed at regular intervals and given further help where necessary. 207 (99%) of the participants were contacted 12 years after the initial assessment.
