Two Fourteenth Century Greek Descriptions of the 'Black Death'

"Black Death" reached Constantinople in the spring of 1347, during the reign of emperor Ioannes VI Cantacuzenos (1341-1355) Procopios was the historian of the plague epidemic of the Justinian era Besides Procopios, Evagrius described, as a witness, the Justinian plague, while Agathias wrote about the 558 plague of Byzantium All gave descriptions of the symptoms and the extent of the disease

London plagues 1348-1665

After the Black Death, plague returned to London many times until its last major outbreak in 1665 The disease usually spread from Asia or the Middle East across Europe to England People were particularly frightened of the plague because its victims died so quickly and very few recovered The worst bout of plague was in 1563, when 24% (nearly a quarter) of London's population died Plague
