During the Falklands War, according to a well-informed senior civil servant, the British government made concerted attempts to keep references to the Chile: deal out of British papers The House of Commons have also repeatedly been misled about the deal with Chile; on 5 July 1982, for example, Foreign Office Minister Cranley Onslow was asked /'whether any bilateral agreements have been made
