The basic source of Egyptian history is a list of rulers compiled in c280 BC by Manetho for the Macedonians who ruled Egypt Manetho divided Egyptian kings into thirty dynasties (a 31st was added later) in the following manner NAME DYNASTY YEARS Archaic Period 1-2 3100-2700 BC Old Kingdom 3-6 2700-2200 BC Intermediate Period 7-10 2200-2050 BC Middle Kingdom 11-12 2050 ...
