The Contemporary Theory of Metaphor George Lakoff

Attitudes to potentially offensive language and gestures ...

How participants experienced and thought about strong language on TV and radio Participants emphasised the importance of context when evaluating potentially offensive language, but had some key concerns Participants recognised that assessing potentially offensive language on TV and radio was not always straightforward Case-by-case judgements were required Participants took into account

Language Development In Children

Many language theorists have labelled various stages of language development Most often these stages are labelled babbling, jargoning, one word utterances, two word utterances, and "all hell breaks loose" (Cole and Cole, Pinker, and Burling) During the babbling stage, children are Language Development 4 learning how to produce the sounds that make up language, a process that Pinker

Basis for rating - Thought content expressed in the interview and its influence on behaviour 1 Absent - Definition does not apply 2 Minimal - Questionable pathology; may be at the upper extreme of normal limits 3 Mild - Presents a guarded or even openly distrustful attitude, but thoughts, interactions and behaviour are minimally affected 4 Moderate - Distrustfulness is clearly evident and
